This is open to any 7th-8th grade 4-H members. Spots are limited, so register today! **Deadline to register is February 14**th.




WOW: Wild Over Wildlife

We are currently accepting deposits for our 2024 Summer Camp. The cost is \$250. This covers transportation, registration, meals and snacks, and 3 nights of accommodation. While at camp, campers will participate in one of (6) educational tracks: Science, Engineering, and Technology; Outdoor Adventures; Hunter Safety; Louisiana Wetlands; Food and Fitness; and Water Safety. Campers will also have recreational time to play various sports, archery, swimming, canoeing, kayaking, stand-up paddle-boarding, and line dancing. Other choices include team-building activities, performing arts and visiting with friends. Evening programs consist of skits, talent shows, Vespers, and special guest speakers. Submit your \$100 non-refundable deposit, along with your form, asap to hold your spot.

The deadline to submit deposits is April 11, 2025. Balance must be paid by May 22, 2025.
